Action Items

Cameron: I make a motion that we adopt the interim general appropriations resolution to get us through until April 7th and approve the 2026/2027 budget. Support by Jaruzel. Roll Call Vote-Yes: Cook, Cameron, Keinath, and Jaruzel. No's- Loomis. Motion Passed

Cameron: I make a motion that we retain Carrie for 1 more year as a consultant for Jackie at the rate she is currently being paid. Support by Keinath. Roll Call Vote-Yes: Cook, Cameron, Keinath, and Jaruzel. No's- Loomis. Motion Passed

Keinath: I move that the Millington Township Board hereby approves and authorizes the issuance of the formal charging documents previously submitted to the Township Board, including those related to Planning Commission members Alvin Zavitz and Ed Maschke, together with the associated evidentiary record incorporated therein, and directs that such charges be served and that hearings be scheduled in accordance with applicable law. I further move that the Township Board authorizes Township legal counsel, Gordon Love, to represent the Township in connection with the pending removal proceedings, including but not limited to the preparation, review, notice, and prosecution of formal charges, providing legal advice to the Board, and the representation of the Township throughout all phases of the removal process pursuant

to applicable law. This authorization shall include all necessary legal services to ensure that the proceedings are conducted in a manner consistent with statutory requirements, due process considerations, and the Township's adopted ordinances. Support by Jaruzel. Roll Call Vote-Yes: Cameron, Keinath, and Jaruzel. No's- Loomis and Cook. Motion Passed

Jaruzel: I move that we use April 7th as the Hearing date for our budget. Support by Cameron. Roll Call Vote-Yes: Cook, Cameron, Loomis, Keinath, and Jaruzel. No's- None. Motion Passed
